Higbee Mill Development Update

You have probably noticed the recent construction activity along Higbee Mill Road after many idle months. The SCA contacted the LFUCG Engineering Department and they reported the original developer recently sold the daycare property to Briggs Commercial Construction. Briggs Construction is now working to complete the daycare building and install the new bridge over South Elkhorn Creek, as well as install a new sidewalk from the corner of Higbee Mill and Cornwall to the daycare. Engineering has inspected the site and the new contractor is working as permitted.

The original developer, TaylorMade Development Group, still owns the townhouse property and work has not yet begun.
